POLICY: REPORTING TO PARENTS

PURPOSE

- To ensure parents have access to and an understanding of their child's progress and achievement across the curriculum.
- 2. To assist with developing and promoting links between the school and home.
- 3. To fulfil statutory obligations.

PROCEDURES

- Reporting to parents will include a Parent Information evening at the beginning of the school year, triadic goal setting with Parents, Students and Teacher in Term 1, Parent-Teacher interviews following a mid-year written report, and a written report at the end of the year.
- Approaches to discuss a child's progress at a time other than those formal times should be by appointment.
- All information relating to students is subject to the Privacy Act provisions. Notice of access to information should be given by a parent or caregiver to the school allowing sufficient time to collate relevant information.
