Dear Families

The gospel on Sunday we hear about Jesus meeting a Samaritan woman at a well. In our country, we have a lot of water and we do not have the same sense of the value of water. In Palestine, Africa and India water is something very precious. Water is life. If there is no water, death comes. When the Bible speaks about water, it speaks about life. The woman is spiritually thirsty as well. When she hears what Jesus is offering she is immediately ready for the living water that he promises. "Sir, give me this living water, that I may never be thirsty or have to keep coming here to draw water." We encounter one another as Jesus once encountered a Samaritan woman: spiritually thirsty, but with ears open, listening to one another, encountering one another and encountering Christ. We, like the Samaritan woman, have known what it means to be thirsty: and we too, have encountered the One who offers us living water, so satisfying that we will never thirst again.

**Attendance Dues:** These are approved by the Minister of Education under Section 447 of the Education Act 1989.


