Teachers have noticed some differences since we have been back at school:

- Students are very settled coming into class by themselves, and are often seated and working before the bell. It would be great if we can keep doing this after moving out of Level 2 as it is making a real difference to our students independence and learning.
- 2. Students are becoming more independent and are managing themselves. This is one of the key competencies of the curriculum.
- 3. There is a general calmness around the school.

We will not be having a written report this term due to teachers not being able to do enough assessment and observations. This is normally about a 6 week process that the lockdown has impacted. 

# Statement for Catholic School Families in Response to the Challenges Encountered by Covid-19

The New Zealand Catholic Bishops have been mindful of the challenges many people in our community are facing during the Covid-19 crisis. We understand the anxiety for parents and caregivers created by a loss of employment or other challenges of caring for children at home during this lockdown.
