



# **Entrance Scholarship Exams - Wentworth College, Gulf Harbour**

Wentworth College is a Private School in Gulf Harbour that follows the Cambridge International Education curriculum. The Wentworth Trust Board offers a number of Entrance Scholarships each year to potential new students wishing to enter Wentworth College. Scholarships are awarded by way of a discount off the annual tuition fees, ranging in value up to 50%. Scholarships are awarded based on the results of scholarship examinations whilst also considering applicants' all round ability (such as sport, cultural and community endeavours). Applicants are required to sit assessments in English and Mathematics, each of approximately one hour's duration. Scholarship examinations for students wishing to enter Wentworth in 2021 will be held on Wednesday, 1st July 2020. 
